	Like the neighboring house at 212 Hagstrom Moad, this house was long occupied in the 19th century by members of the Chaffee family.						
SIGNIFICANCE	The house probably dates to the late 18th century, but surviving exterior detailing largely the result of a mid 19th century remodelling in the Greek Revival manner. paneled entry and corner pilasters and wide frieze were intended to suggest the colustormal entablatures, and massive masonry construction of a classical Greek temple. Greek Revival style was most popular from about 1835 to 1860; the application of su layers of trim to older farmhouses is typical of small town New England.
