

Dr. Elliott P. Joslin (1869-1962)

The first doctor in the U. S. to specialize in diabetes and founder of Joslin Diabetes Center, Boston, MA., for treatment and research of diabetes. He was born and raised in Oxford, MA. But his ancestors (Joslin and Bates) were from the northeast corner of Thompson for several generations. He lived in Brookline and Boston, MA; and is buried in Oxford with his parents.
