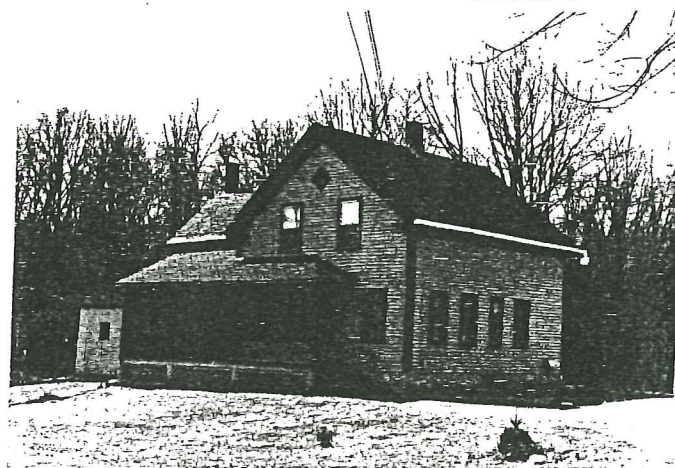

DESCRIPTION (Continued)	17 OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING OR SITE (interior and/or exterior)
	<p>Four-bay facade, entry in third bay. Wood door has a single large light over panels. Sash generally 2-over-2. Plain corner boards, narrow plain frieze; molded cornice shows partial return. Small diamond shaped attic window. Porch covers all but fourth bay, extends to meet lower cross-gabled left wing. Porch has square chamfered Italianate posts, molded rail, square balusters, plain frieze, molded cornice.</p> <p>Right elevation plain. Left wing has side entry, adjoins shed with original heavy paneled door.</p>

SIGNIFICANCE	19 HISTORICAL OR ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE
	<p>Loisa White, born in Thompson in 1827, was the longtime occupant and probable builder of this house. Mrs. White's husband David, a farmer, died in 1860. This building was probably erected about 1870; she apparently lived in it until her death in 1905.</p> <p>Architecturally, the building is significant as a good and unusually well preserved example of late 19th century vernacular design. The narrow frieze and corner pilasters show the continuing influence of the Greek Revival style.</p>
