Ballord, Zaccheus, born 1730, died 1800,

Served from Oxford, Mass, 4<sup>th</sup> Massachusetts Volunteer At Valley Forge the winter of 1777-78

Bates, John, died Dec 12, 1834, age 86 yrs

Served from Attleborough, Mass Pvt under Capt Jacob Ide, Col Daggett, 1776

Walker, William, died Dec 13, 1843 age 84 yrs 11 mos Served from Rhode Island Pvt under Capt King, Col Atwell He received a pension in later years

**War of 1812** (Thompson Militia responded to defend New London Although battle did not occur)

Ballord/Ballard, Lynde died June 9, 1825 age 51 yrs Bates, John, Esq., died July 2, 1863 age 83 yrs

# Civil War (GAR)

Bates, Francis, son of John & Mary Ann, died April 5, 1864
age 21 yrs,1 mo,7days of measles
Served as Pvt, 51<sup>st</sup> Infantry Massachusetts, 25 Sep 1862
to 27 Jul 1863

George, Andrew L., died Aug 24, 1877, age 37 yrs 1 mo 6 days

Served in the 25<sup>th</sup> Massachusetts Volunteers 1861-1864

Was in a home for disabled volunteer soldiers in Maine
1871-til his death

Craver, Bates Bartlett, born 1891, died 1958 Corporal Army
